Reactivity in Rommies

Reactivity is a dog reacting to a stimulus, this reaction can look aggressive but is often due to fear. Your dog may be reactive to new things whilst they are settling in due to their backgrounds such as a lack of exposure to a lot of things they will experience in the UK or perhaps they have had a negative experience with it in the past.

If your dog is starting to exhibit reactive behaviours do not make them deal with anything they are not comfortable with, you do not want them to get over threshold. Take is slowly and use positive reinforcement to slowly expose your dog to whatever is triggering them. Dont expect their reactivity to be fixed over night. This could take a long time. Feel free to contact the rescue for advice or guidance on where to find a positive reinforcement professional.
